David is only 6 years old and has faced so many challenges in his life. He needs constant care and supervision as he is autistic, has ADHD and a cognitive disability.

His background is tragic. His father suffers from severe mental illness and has been absent most of David's life. His mother devoted herself to her son and is now very ill with brain cancer and can no longer look after him.

Ohel Sarah has opened a new home and now David has the care he so desperately needs.

His family know he is safe and being given the highest standards of care and support.

A new home for David and a first for Israel.

David's new home is for 6 very young boys aged 6-12 years, who all have complex needs and behaviour problems.

This is a completely new initiative and has never been done by any other organisation in Israel.

If their own families are unable to care for them, children at this young age usually go to foster families. However, these children have such challenging behaviours that no foster families could be found.

So, Ohel Sarah has opened this new, specialist children's home, where our dedicated and professional staff will provide 24-hour care and attention.
